In a box labelled GREEN CHURCH PROJECT, on the table just inside the Mercille office entrance (across from the coat rack), we ask you to drop off used batteries, printer cartridges and old cell phones in order to bring them to appropriate disposal facilities. We do not accept any light bulbs.
