There are newspapers and brown paper bags near compost bucket that is found in the kitchen. Feel free to empty bucket contents into city's brown bin outside using newspaper or brown paper to keep bin dry~ish. Please help us to compost as much as possible.

We collect some toxic waste. In a box labelled GREEN CHURCH PROJECT, on the table just inside the Mercille office entrance (across from the coat rack), we ask you to drop off used batteries, printer cartridges and old cell phones in order to bring them to appropriate disposal facilities. We do not accept any light bulbs.
